

## COOPERATION AGREEMENT I

Agreement between Collins Orido Wasonga (CBO, Agape Hope for Kibera) and Margriet Kuijper (Chair person Stichting Stimulering Doekunst) and Luuk de Vries (Secretary, Stichting Stimulering Doekunst).

1. The Dutch foundation Stichting Stimulering Doekunst supports the mission of Agape Hope for Kibera (see attachment I), by actively applying for funds in the Netherlands and abroad.
2. Stichting Stimulering Doekunst acts as an intermediary to facilitate the Online Slum Tour organised by Agape Hope for Kibera. Payments from clients of the Online Slum Tour are transferred to the bank account of Stichting Stimulering Doekunst. The board of Stichting Stimulerings Doekunst transfers the revenues from the online slum tours within two weeks to the bank account of Agape Hope for Kibera (see attachment II for flowchart).
3. Clients of the online slum tour pay €50,- per tour. The board of Stichting Stimulering Doekunst deducts €5,- per tour for expenses, such as maintenance of the website, international wire transfers and to use as means for application for certain funds. The remaining €45,- will be transferred to the bank account of Agape Hope for Kibera.
4. Agape Hope for Kibera will use the online tour revenues to pay for the costs of organizing the tours and to achieve the aims of Agape Hope for Kibera, as described in their mission.
5. The board of Agape Hope for Kibera sends an annual report of the progress and outcomes of projects they have initiated and financially supported.



## **Attachment I: Mission Agape Hope for Kibera**

**AGAPE HOPE FOR KIBERA** is a Community Based organisation which was started in 2006. But got registered in the year 2010.

**OUR VISION.** To ensure that the whole community gets access to the best quality of life

**OUR MISSION:** Believe in Building partnership transforming life. We give special attention to orphans, youths and other vulnerable groups.

We currently work in Nairobi with plans to spread to other slums in Nairobi.

Over the past years we have been able to embark on an OVC programme (orphans and vulnerable children) which currently has 65 vulnerable children. We currently offer early childhood education to the children. We also offer porridge for breakfast and hot lunch and provide them with school uniforms and stationaries.

### **Agape Hope for Kibera mandate is to:**

1. Education on behavioural change and communication and linking community institution for support
2. Giving equal care for the children with emphasis on girls.
3. Training of youth leaders, job placements and skills.
4. Engaging kids and youths in Arts / Theatre all these are in an effort to keep them away from substance abuse and criminal activities.
5. Promotion of clean fun for the youth and children by initiating clean fun activities.
6. We also carry our Kibera Tour for organized groups and individuals.
7. We also do youth outreach to schools and to street kids and mentorship.
